*Safety Matters* is an interactive training program that focuses on equipping young people with the skills and knowledge they need to participate in safe and healthy work environments throughout their working lives.

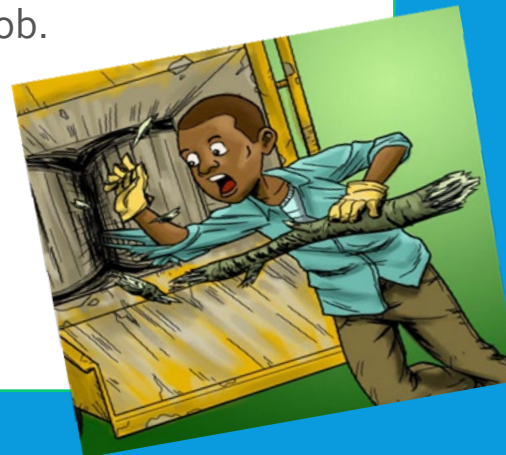
### Did You Know?

Approximately 1.6 million U.S. teens (aged 15–17) work.  
Every nine minutes, a U.S. teen is injured on the job.

*On average, each year:*

59,800 workers under the age of 18 are sent to the ER for job-related injuries.

37 workers under the age of 18 die on the job.
